Individual Membership - \$150.00 per year

With this membership, CAWIC offers women the opportunity to network with peers, promote their businesses and gain support through the experiences of other women.

Open to women who are, or have been, actively employed in the construction industry or construction related services. Membership belongs to the individual and is non-transferable.

Membership includes subscription to the CAWIC Newsletter, discounts on partnered vendors and services, mentoring, members-only functions, listing in the online membership directory, free resume posting, unlimited networking opportunities, members-only access to on-line information through the CAWIC website, reduced fees at CAWIC events, voting privileges, and more.

Corporate Bundle Membership - \$625.00 per year includes up to 3 members; additional employee members \$100.00 each per year.

Corporate Membership provides businesses and organizations with the right exposure to position them at the forefront of the industry and with the opportunity to demonstrate their support of women in construction.

Open to companies and organizations that are involved in the construction industry or related services. Membership belongs to the company listed and is non-transferable. In addition to the first 3 employee members, subsequent employees may be registered separately at a cost of \$100.00 each. The bundle administrator can add, remove or revise the assigned employee members included with the Corporate Bundle Membership. Voting privileges are given to each member.
